The main case load is small animal but there is also the potential to restart the equine ophthalmology clinic. We have a dedicated equine consultation room and operating theatre, as well as the ability to hospitalize equine patients with the necessary supportive staff.

The ophthalmology unit is well equipped and has a busy medical and surgical caseload. Our clinic contains all the facilities expected of an advanced referral clinic. As well as top of the range diagnostic equipment we have;

- Radiotherapy suite comprising a Clinac 23EX linear accelerator
- HDR brachytherapy.
