



## Ophthalmology RESIDENCY

Dick White Referrals is a state-of-the-art, multi-disciplinary small animal referral clinic in the beautiful county of Cambridgeshire with easy access to Cambridge and London.

Established in 2003; DWR has now become one of the most-recognised small animal referral hospitals in the UK. The growing Specialist team currently comprises over 25 European, RCVS and American specialists in the fields of anaesthesiology, cardiology, dermatology, internal medicine, neurology, oncology, ophthalmology, orthopaedic and soft tissue surgery, pathology and clinical pathology and is backed by a highly qualified nursing team, physiotherapists and support staff.

We are now seeking a colleague to join our ophthalmology team as an ECVO resident. The ophthalmology team currently comprises three ECVO Diplomates, three residents and two dedicated nurses.

The residency programme will be for a period of three to four years (reviewed after six months and then annually). The position will be available commencing March 2018.

Available facilities include the usual diagnostic and surgical equipment including external and fundus photography, operating microscope with video system, phacoemulsification unit, cryotherapy, CXL- unit, on-site MRI and CT scanner. We also have online access to a university's medical library and actively contribute to the clinical teaching of students from the University of Nottingham.
